Fabriano Carta è Cultura reaches its third edition. A milestone that marks the continuity of a vision launched in 2023 and now increasingly shared: an event that places paper at the center—not only as an identifying element of the city, but as a living, generative material, capable of connecting different worlds and building bridges between past and future. Since 2013, Fabriano has been a UNESCO Creative City and former national coordinator of the Italian Creative Cities Network, making paper the symbol of a craft that spans centuries. Carta è Cultura stands as the space where that heritage engages in dialogue with the challenges of the present.

The theme chosen for 2025 takes inspiration from the UNESCO Annual Conference in Enghien-les-Bains, dedicated to the relationship between culture and artificial intelligence. "Culture and Artificial Intelligence: Shaping the Future of UNESCO Creative Cities" is more than just a title: it is an invitation to reflect on how cultural languages can contribute to making the adoption of AI in urban contexts more conscious, inclusive, and sustainable. The third edition of Carta è Cultura moves precisely along this frontier: paper—the medium of memory, thought, and creativity—meets artificial intelligence, a technology that profoundly transforms communication, production, and imagination. It is a meeting between matter and algorithm, between slowness and speed, between artisanal tradition and digital innovation.

Within this framework, Carta è Cultura becomes an open and plural laboratory where writers, artists, publishers, scholars, entrepreneurs, designers, students, and citizens explore the opportunities and responsibilities offered by new technologies, in the belief that culture and intelligence, when properly directed, can guide the transformations of contemporary society. Once again this year, the event grows thanks to the contribution of a broad and active network of local, national, and international partners.

The challenge of the third edition is this: to explore artificial intelligence through the tools of culture and creativity, in order to continue building a city that is open, aware, and sustainable.

Fabriano Carta è Cultura 2025, Fabriano Carta è Cultura 2025, now in its third edition, confirms itself as an annual flagship event within the Fabriano Creativa program. It enhances and underscores the role and importance of culture in line with UNESCO's guidelines, while strengthening the city's identity as a laboratory of creativity, inclusion, and future vision.

Within this framework, this year will also host the Annual Meeting of the Italian UNESCO Creative Cities Network (UCCN), a pivotal moment in the activities of the Italian UCCN.

Fabriano will become a place of reflection and dialogue on the theme "Culture and Artificial Intelligence: Shaping the Future of UNESCO Creative Cities", presented at the UNESCO Annual Global Conference held in Enghien-les-Bains (Paris) in June 2025. The Conference explored innovative ways of integrating Artificial Intelligence (AI) with cultural development to promote sustainable urban growth, focusing attention on the intersection of cultural heritage and digital innovation, and considering Al's emerging role in the world of culture and the arts.

The Conference highlighted the transformative potential of AI in culture, showing how technology can enhance cultural life, public engagement, and creativity in all its forms.

The interaction between technological evolution, culture, and sustainability presents both challenges and opportunities, emphasizing the importance of human-centered Al applications in cultural and creative sectors.

UNESCO Creative Cities, as centers of innovation, play a crucial role in shaping new frameworks and environments for cultural and creative sectors, ensuring that the adoption of artificial intelligence is responsible, inclusive, and ethical, and applied with integrity. Fabriano Carta è Cultura addresses the key themes put forward by UNESCO: the promotion of a sustainable culture, accessibility and democratic participation in cultural life, dialogue between tradition and innovation, and the ethics and impact of AI in creative processes and cultural production—while remaining closely connected to the most pressing issues facing the city and its many communities.

Paper—the symbolic element of Fabriano and the protagonist of the event—understood both as a physical support of memory and as a metaphor for cultural transformation, continues to be the guiding thread of a rich, multidisciplinary program of exhibitions, installations, screenings, readings, concerts, talks, and workshops. Leading this year's journey is an exploration of Artificial Intelligence as both a critical and creative tool: an opportunity to reflect on how emerging technologies are redefining the artistic act and the processes of cultural production and participation.

Fabriano Carta è Cultura is an invitation to rethink the value of traditional mediums in the age of hyper-technology, recognizing paper as a meeting ground between roots and innovation, matter and thought, analog and digital—anchored in the concrete reality of today.

The creativity that Fabriano embodies has the power to foster cultural innovation, inclusivity, and resilience, reinforcing the importance of urban growth guided by culture. Being a Creative City does not only mean valuing historical and artistic heritage, but also promoting cultural industries, investing in education, supporting contemporary production, and building collaborative networks among artists, institutions, businesses, and citizens—generating economic opportunities, territorial attractiveness, and social well-being through the enjoyment of beauty and the strengthening of critical thinking and civic participation.


